Vocabulary

- **Time zone**- a region in which all the clocks are set to the same time.
- **Greenwich Meantime**- the solar time that is determined at the prime meridian through Greenwich, England, and that is used to calculate and regulate time throughout most of the world; Greenwich mean time.
- **Border**- edge; boundary.
- **Location**- place or position.
- **Population**- the people who live in an area, considered as a group.
- **Tourism**- the act of traveling, usually for sightseeing or relaxing.
- **Tourist**- a person who is travelling for pleasure.
- **Mountain range**- a group of mountains.
- **Climate**- the weather over a period of time
