

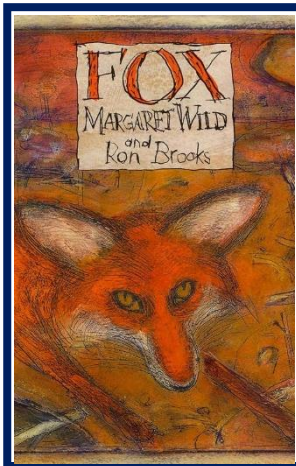

Text Type Features

- Use specific and some technical vocabulary e.g. omnivore.
- Use precision in technical vocabulary.
- Use description to compare and contrast e.g. bats are one of the smallest mammals.
- Write in the present tense.
- Use layout features e.g. questions to draw in the reader, headings and sub-headings and paragraphs to group related ideas.

Writer's Knowledge

- Add the prefixes 'min' and 'non' to words to form nouns.
- Use conjunctions to join two clauses together.
- Use the present perfect form of a verb when you describe something that has happened in the past and is still happening.
- Use commas to separate items in a list.
- Use noun phrases to describe something in detail.
