

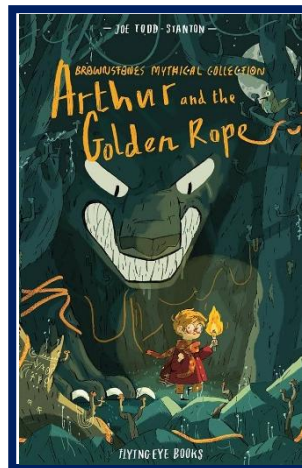

Text Type Features

- Plot either a journey or a quest for the hero.
- Include incredible or miraculous events.
- Create characters which behave in superhuman ways with unusual powers. The characters need a magic object, which is symbolic of something.
- Include a hero and a villain.
- Ensure the pace of the narrative is fast.

Writer's Knowledge

- Use a possessive apostrophe to show that something belongs to plural nouns.
- Add adjectives and prepositions in noun phrases to add detail.
- Use a variety of nouns and pronouns to avoid repetition and keep the reader interested.
- Use fronted adverbials (punctuated with a comma) to show the time, place and manner.
- Use conjunctions to join sentences together.
