## Sticky Knowledge

- Human features are landmarks built by humans, e.g. town/village, house, office, shop
- Physical features are natural, e.g. forest, hill, river, soil.
- Aerial photographs are a still image taken from above
- Maps show a place and can be used to help us find our way
- Land can have lots of different uses

## Vocabulary

**Map**- something that shows a place and can be used to help us find our way

**Symbol**- used to represent a landmark on a map

**Human feature**- landmarks built by humans

**Physical feature**- are natural

**Aerial**- a still image from above

**Local**- near where you are

**Landmark**- a significant feature of the area

**Town** - a built-up area with a name, defined boundaries, and local government, that is larger than a village and generally smaller than a city.
