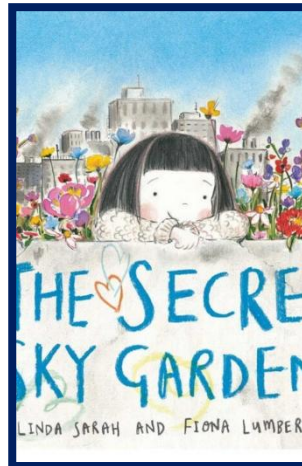

### Text Type Features

- Use small details to: describe characters; describe time, place and mood; and to evoke a response within your reader.
- Include an introduction, build up, climax and resolution.
- Use paragraphs and introduce these differently.
- Create dialogue between characters that shows their relationship with each other.
  - Use 1<sup>st</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> person consistently.
  - Use tenses appropriately.

### Writer's Knowledge

- Use the correct form of verbs to make sure writing is grammatically correct.
- Use an apostrophe to show that something belongs to more than one noun.
  - Add prepositions to expanded noun phrases to show where something is.
- Use pronouns to avoid repetition and to keep your reader interested.
- Use (punctuated) fronted adverbials to describe when, where or how the action happened.
  - Use direct speech.
