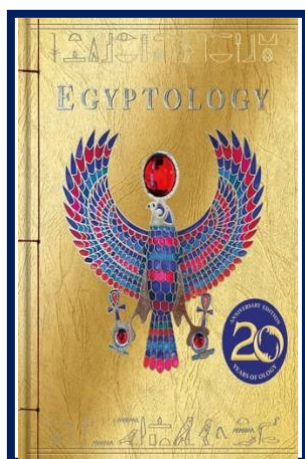

-
- Questions to exaggerate the mystery.
- Dialogue to advance the action or create tension.
- Add an ingredient into a setting or character to trigger a mystery.
- Use adventurous word choices.
- Language to intensify the mystery: puzzling, strange, baffling, weird.
- Make a character seem mysterious through their actions or dialogue.

Writer's Knowledge

- Accurate use of 'a' or 'an'
- Expressing time, place and cause using adverbs.
- Use a wider range of conjunctions.
- Use questions.
